In accordance with the provisions of article 227 of the revised text of the Securities Market Act, approved by Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of October 23, Audax Renovables, S.A. (the **"Company"**) communicates the following:

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

Audax Renovables (ADX.MC), a vertically integrated Spanish energy group that generates 100% renewable energy and supplies electricity and gas to customers in seven European countries, has acquired the Zaratán photovoltaic project in the municipality of Ciguñuela (Valladolid), which already has all the administrative permits to begin construction in early 2022. It is estimated that the investment will be around 8 million euros.

The plant will occupy a total area of 25 hectares, will have a total capacity of 12.36 MWp and will be Audax's first facility in Castilla y León. The facility will generate the equivalent of the energy consumption of almost 5,500 households and around 17,000 people, and its commitment to clean energy will prevent the emission into the atmosphere of 3,840 tonnes of CO₂ per year.

The company is continuing its strategy of focusing on generation activity and expects the plant to come on stream in the third quarter of 2022 and start feeding power into the grid.

Over the coming weeks, the Group will continue to inform the market on a regular basis about the progress of the projects in its portfolio, in order to keep its stakeholders and its investors permanently informed.
